Inside St. Paul's

Church Council Meeting Minutes

- The Council made the very difficult decision to continue with a 2/3 time Interim Pastor contract for the next six months. Pastor Bob will be continuing as our Interim Pastor, and we will address needs as we get to Spring of 2022. We thank Pastor Brent for having been there when we needed him during the first six months of our Interim period!
- Confirmation classes continue every Wednesday. It is suggested that students arrive in time for the 6:30 PM service prior to the start of class in order to enrich their confirmation experience. Parents are encouraged to join their children.
- Our Education Committee is proposing a 10 week course for Sunday School Students that will begin in January 2022, and culminate with a performance at our Easter service. The next course would begin in the Fall of 2022 and culminate with a performance at our Christmas service. Parents of Sunday School aged children should reach out to the church office to ensure their children are placed on an enrollment list! AND Parents are encouraged to volunteer to assist in the teaching of the children.
- The Worship Committee is planning the All Saints Day Service for November 7, which remembers and recognizes those members who have passed away since last All Saints Day. They are also seeking volunteer Lectors/Prayer Leaders. We are trying to return to this aspect of our services, with the Lector/Prayer Leader being stationed at a podium and microphone away from the altar to maintain proper distancing.
- All of our committees are seeking member participants, including Mutual Ministry, Combined Committee, Education and Worship. Some of these committees meet just once per quarter. If you have questions about the tasks assigned to these committees, please contact the church office to be directed to that Committee's Chair.
- The Church Council is preparing an amendment to our Bylaws that decreases the number of Council members from 9 to 7 beginning in January of 2022.
- The Call Committee is working toward meeting with Holy Trinity to discuss the possibility of a Shared Pastor arrangement (this is NOT a "part-time" Pastoral arrangement).




