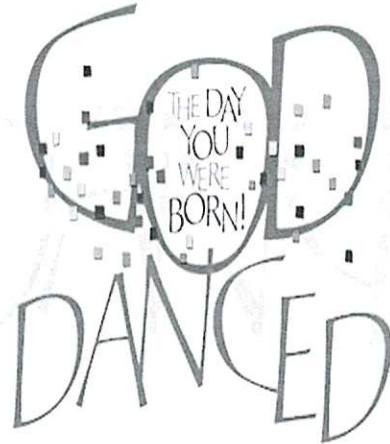

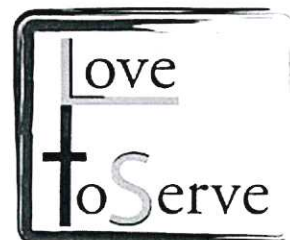

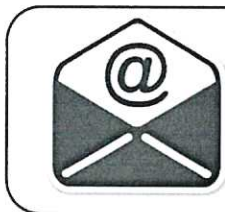


Pie & Ice Cream Fundraiser

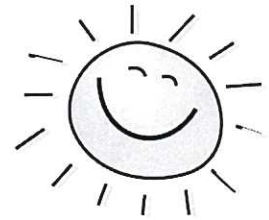

Dear Friends at St. Paul's,

This is my favorite time of year!

I love the long daylight hours. I love being up early and sitting on my patio with my morning coffee. I love getting out side chores done while the day is bright with sunshine but the temperature is still cool.

I love the long evenings too! It is a joy to sit out and watch the gorgeous color of the sunset. The birds sing in the early morning. The Crickets and frogs serenade me in the dusk. No wonder the poet James Russell Lowell could write "What is so rare as a day in June? Then, if ever, come perfect days".

There is just no doubt that there are times when nature reveals the splendor of God through it's beauty. At those times it is easy to feel that the God who created all of this loves us very much.

But what about those times when nature is less warm and wonderful? During a January blizzard or an October hurricane. What message is nature giving about God? Even during mostly wonderful June a tornado can form and suddenly the natural world is dark and threatening; and sometimes evil breaks out in death and destruction.

Nature gives a mixed message. Sometimes it speaks clearly of a wondrous and loving God. But, sometimes it speaks in way, that makes us wonder about God, or even question God's existence.

There is a place, however , where God promises always to be. In the Word and Sacraments. The Word is clear that God is love: "For God so loved the world." (John 3:16). The sacraments make it clear that this love extends to you: "This is my body/blood given for you!"

So This June enjoy God's wonderful creation and what it is able to reveal about God. But, come to church to hear the word and share in the sacraments. They will always assure us of God's unfailing and unmistakable love.
